On May 2, 2015 an Oakland police officer ran a red light and struck Ms. Olike's 2011 Mercedes SUV at the intersection of 17th and Castro totaling the vehicle and causing Ms. Olike and her daughter to sustain neck and back pain and soft tissue injuries. Ms. Olike and her daughter incurred medical bills of approximately \$2,400.00. Under this settlement the insurer will receive \$36,115.52 and Ms. Olike and her daughter will receive \$10,000 for medical and other damages. This settlement will resolve all claims in this matter.
