FACTS OF THE CASE:

Ms. Panameno suffered a fractured wrist when she tripped and fell on an uneven tree well in the sidewalk near Webster and 19th Streets. She walked on the tree well to move around a person sitting on the sidewalk waiting for medical attention. The fracture required surgical repair and will require further surgery to remove pins and a plate; and she lost three months of wages due to leave required for recovery. Ms. Panameno sued the city for maintaining a dangerous condition. The settlement will resolve all claims.
